### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Mailing Address of Grantees or Mortgagees on Deeds and Other Conveyances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 33, §§ 456 and 457, additional. Title 33 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding 2 new sections to read as follows:

### § 456. Address of buyer

All deeds and other instruments for the conveyance of real property shall contain, in addition to the name of the grantee, his address, including street and number and state.

### § 457. Error or omission of mailing address

Any error in or omission of mailing address of grantee or mortgagee in the deed, mortgage or other conveyance, required by any provision of this Title, shall not affect in any way the validity or effectiveness of such deed, mortgage or other conveyance of real estate.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of the bill is to aid municipal tax assessors in determining the addresses of nonresident buyers of real estate.
