HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 302, L. D. 402, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Definition of Class A Restaurant Under Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 7th line  
(5th line of L. D.) the underlined figure "\$20,000" and inserting  
in place thereof the underlined figure '\$30,000'; and by striking  
out in the 10th line (8th line of L. D.) the underlined figure  
"\$12,000" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure  
'\$18,000'; and by striking out in the 14th line (11th line of L. D.)  
the underlined figure "\$10,000" and inserting in place thereof  
the underlined figure '\$20,000'; and by striking out in the  
17th line (13th line of L. D.) the underlined figure "\$6,000"  
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$12,000'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to raise the minimum amount  
of food sold by Class A restaurants.
