HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 308, L. D. 408, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Indian Representatives at the Legislature, Tribal Governors, Lieutenant Governors and Council Members."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Indian tribal governors, lieutenant governors, council members; how paid. The Indian tribal governors, lieutenant governors and council members shall be paid from the Department of Indian Affairs "All Other" account line category.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General

Fund to the Department of Indian Affairs the sum of \$21,780 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows: $\frac{1971-72}{\text{INDIAN AFFAIRS, DEPARTMENT OF}} \frac{1972-73}{\text{INDIAN AFFAIRS, DEPARTMENT OF}}$

All Other \$9,900 \$11,880'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the language "as provided for in the Part II Budget of the Department of Indian Affairs" and to add a section 2 to the bill providing for an appropriation.
