COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 308, L. D. 408, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Indian Representatives at the Legislature,
Tribal Governors, Lieutenant Governors and Council Members."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words
and punctuation "Representatives at the Legislature,"

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Indian tribal governors, lieutenant governors, council
members; how paid. The Indian tribal governors, lieutenant
governors and council members shall be paid from the Department
of Indian Affairs "All Other" account line category as provided
for in the Part II Budget of the Department of Indian Affairs.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to delete all references
to the Indian Representatives at the Legislature.
