STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Indian Representatives at the Legislature, Tribal
Governors, Lieutenant Governors and Council Members.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Indian Representatives, tribal governors, lieutenant governors, council members; how paid. The Indian Representatives at the Legislature, tribal governors, lieutenant governors and council members shall be paid from the Department of Indian Affairs "All Other" account line category as provided for in the Part II Budget of the Department of Indian Affairs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Under the present arrangement of the Department of Indian Affairs only the governor and lieutenant governor receive "stipend" amounts for the governor and lieutenant governor and provided funds for the representatives to the Legislature and council members.
