**AN ACT Relating to Snow Removal on State Highways in Built-up Sections
of Certain Municipalities.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1001, amended. The first sentence of the last paragraph of section 1001 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The maintenance provisions of sections 705, 751, 1001, 1002, 1003, 1005, 1008 and 1011 shall not apply to those compact or built-up sections of state highway in cities or towns whose population according to the last U. S. census exceeds 5,000 inhabitants, except for maintenance of secondary federal aid projects, and the snow removal provisions shall not apply to those compact or built-up sections, and "compact areas" as determined by the commission, in which compact sections are intermittent and separated by a short interval or intervals of sections that are not compact, of state highway in cities or towns whose population according to the last U. S. census exceeds ~~2,000~~ 2,500 inhabitants.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to aid certain municipalities in snow removal from state highways in the built-up sections within the municipality by making such removal the responsibility of the State.
