#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Turn and Stop Signals on Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1192, amended. The last sentence of section 1192 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 248 of the public laws of 1965 and as amended by chapter 185 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

If said signals are given by a lamp or lamps, such lamp or lamps shall emit a white to amber light to the front and a red to amber light to the rear for turn signals and red to the rear for stop signals.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

When section 1192 of Title 29 was rewritten to comply with the Uniform Vehicle Code in the last session of the Legislature, the portion of the section pertaining to the use of red lamps for a stop signal was omitted.
