HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 318, L. D. 418, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Retirement Benefits for Forest Rangers under State  
Retirement System."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General  
Fund the sum of \$28,448 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The
