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**AN ACT Relating to Waiver of Certification of Certain Water Utilities.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 22, § 2450, amended.** Section 2450 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 209 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by inserting after the 2nd sentence the following new sentence to read as follows:

**The commissioner may further grant a waiver for a period not exceeding one year to a water utility serving not more than 250 services in the event that the certification requirements cannot be met.**

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The purpose of this bill is to permit the Commissioner of Health and Welfare to waive certification by the Board for certification for certain water utilities.
