STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing Funds for the Maine Golf Swing Tour.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Emergency preamble. Whereas, resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, a Maine golf swing tour to include 6 tournaments in various parts of the State will be organized during the summer of 1971; and

Whereas, the tour will encourage out-of-state golfers to remain in Maine during the entire tour and to exploit more fully the state's magnificent golf facilities; and

Whereas, additional funds are vitally necessary to help sponsor the tour, which in turn will help generate funds for many businesses and such funds must be available before the season begins; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Funds for Maine golf swing tour. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,500 to help sponsor the Maine golf swing tour for the year 1971; and be it further

Unencumbered balances. Resolved: That any unencumbered balances remaining on June 30, 1971 shall not lapse but shall be carried forward until June 30, 1972.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this legislation is reflected in the emergency preamble.
