### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Haynesville for Development of a Recreational Area.

Town of Haynesville; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 to the Town of Haynesville. This money will be applied to the development of a rest and recreational area along the Mattawamkeag River on Route 2-A in Haynesville.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The land which the town already owns will make an ideal rest area in a long strip of woods. The town needs this money to help develop it.
