AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Clerk of Courts of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Aroostook County: County commissioners, \$1,500, except that one member of the board, designated by the board as chief administrative officer, shall receive \$5,500; clerk of courts, ~~\$6,000~~ \$8,500; county attorney, \$8,500; assistant county attorney, \$5,500; county treasurer, \$3,500; sheriff, \$6,500; register of deeds, northern district, \$5,500; southern district, \$5,500; judge of probate, \$4,500; register of probate, \$4,000.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salary of the clerk of courts of Aroostook County from \$6,000 to \$8,500.
