STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to School Construction Aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3457, amended. The last sentence of the 11th paragraph of section 3457 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 475 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Before computing the eligible expenditure of any administrative unit for construction aid, the commissioner shall cause to be deducted all moneys, except federal funds received by municipalities for Model Cities programs and other human needs programs besides education, expended on the project which were received from federal sources.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to take into account federal funds in computing state aid construction for schools.
