STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Posting Beaver Flowages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2360-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2360-A to read as follows:

§ 2360-A. Posting of beaver flowages

Whenever the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game removes beaver from a beaver flowage, an appropriate notice shall be posted conspicuously at the beaver flowage by the department indicating that the beaver have been removed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

At the present time if beaver are removed from a beaver flowage, the trapper is not notified and continues to trap for beaver that are no longer present. The purpose of this bill is to give such notice to the trapper.
