AN ACT Increasing Salaries of District Court Judges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 157, amended. The 4th sentence of section 157 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Each judge shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$16,000~~ \$19,500 and the Chief Judge shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$17,000~~ \$20,500.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$116,375 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
