STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Name of The Electronic Technicians' Association, Inc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Electronic Technicians' Association, Inc.; authority to change name. The Electronic Technicians' Association, Inc. is granted the authority to use the name "The Maine Electronic Technicians' Association, Inc."

STATEMENT OF FACT

Since The Electronic Technicians' Association, Inc. serves the entire State, the purpose of this bill is to establish the identity of the association by permitting it to use the word "Maine" in its title.
