AN ACT Relating to Precautions at Railroad Crossings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 818, repealed. Section 818 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this legislation is to repeal an antiquated statute which in its present form obliges the driver of a vehicle to get out of his vehicle and look up and down a railroad track before crossing.
