IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Drinking in Unlicensed Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 17, § 2003, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 2003 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 2. Public place defined. "Public place" as used in this section shall mean any common carrier, dance, entertainment, amusement or sport or grounds adjacent thereto and used in conjunction therewith or any highway, street or, lane or any place where admission is charged to which the public is invited or has access.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide better control over drinking in or at unlicensed premises.
