SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H. P. 364, L. D. 471, Bill, "AN ACT to Pay for One Hundred Percent of Health Insurance Plans for State Employees."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, §285, sub-§2-A, additional. Section 285 of Title 5 of the Revised Stabutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 2-A, to read as follows:

2-A. Application. The specifications drawn by the board for the health insurance plan shall include basic hospital and medical care benefits and major medical benefits, and comparable benefits for employees who rely solely on spiritual means for healing.'

Further amend said Bill by menumbering sections 1 to 4 to be sections 2 to 5.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit state employees who rely on spiritual means for healing to be covered by the accident and sickness or health insurance program.
