SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H. P. 364, L. D. 471, Bill, "AN ACT to Pay for One Hundred Percent of Health Insurance Plans for State Employees."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, §285, sub-§2-A, additional. Section 285 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 2-A, to read as follows:

2-A. Application. The specifications drawn by the board for the health insurance plan shall include basic hospital and medical care benefits and major medical benefits, and comparable benefits for employees who rely solely on spiritual means for healing.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 to 4 to be sections 2 to 5.


Statement of Fact
