AN ACT Relating to Health Warnings on Labels on Liquor Bottles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 10, additional. Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 10, to read as follows:

§ 10. Warnings on labels

There shall be printed in at least 8-point Gothic style type on the label of each bottle of liquor sold or offered for sale in the State of Maine the following:

WARNING

Contents may be addicting or habit forming and injurious to your health.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This legislation would require on each bottle of liquor offered for sale or sold in the State of Maine that a health warning be printed on the label.
