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**RESOLVE**, to Reimburse Ripley & Fletcher Co. of South Paris for  
**Gasoline Shrinkage.**

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Ripley & Fletcher Co.; appropriation for. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$474.90 to reimburse Ripley & Fletcher Co. of South Paris to cover loss of gasoline through shrinkage.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Under the Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 2906, a gasoline distributor may be reimbursed for loss through shrinkage if a claim is filed with the State Tax Assessor. This claim was not submitted until after the deadline for filing such claims and the purpose of this bill is to provide for the necessary reimbursement.
