AN ACT Relating to Length of Combination of Motor Vehicles and
Semitrailers Transporting Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 244, amended. The 4th paragraph from the end of section 244 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 54 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read as follows:

However, a combination of motor vehicle and semitrailer exclusively engaged in the transportation of motor vehicles shall be allowed to attain a maximum length of 55 feet, excluding the usual or ordinary bumper overhang of the transported vehicles.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to establish the maximum length of a combination motor vehicle and semitrailer exclusively engaged in the transportation of motor vehicles.
