COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 360, L. D. 482, Bill, "AN ACT Creating the Dexter Utility District."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the last 2 lines (same in L. D.) the following: ", other than for storm or surface water, as hereinafter provided" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'and incidental storm and surface waters as hereinafter provided'

Further amend said Bill in section 11 by striking out all of the last sentence of the last paragraph which reads as follows: "All bonds, notes and evidences of indebtedness issued by said district shall be legal investments for savings banks in the State of Maine."

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include facilities for storm and surface waters and to eliminate an unnecessary provision and thus prevent a possible conflict with the savings bank laws.
