STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing Moneys for Eastern Regional Conference of the Council of State Governments to be Held in Maine in 1971.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, in order to take preparatory steps to bring the Eastern Regional Conference of the Council of State Governments to Maine in 1971, the following legislation is necessary; and

Whereas, to hold the conference in Maine in 1971 is extremely desirable for the economic well-being of the inhabitants of Maine since at least 100 people from the eastern section of the United States will attend; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Commission on Interstate Cooperation the sum of \$1,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 to aid in defraying the expenses of holding the Eastern Regional Conference of the Council of State Governments in Maine in the fall of 1971.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall become effective July 1, 1971.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the emergency preamble.
