HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 163, L. D. 485, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to Preference to Maine Workmen and Contractors."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of
subsection 7 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'7. Public authority. "Public authority" means any officer,
board or commission or other agency of the State of Maine,
authorized by law to enter into contracts for the construction of
public works, which construction is supported in whole or in part
by public funds of the State of Maine, and sections 1304 to 1313
shall apply to expenditures made in whole or in part from such
public funds.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is not to change the definition
of "public authority" under the present law.
