SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S. P. 163, L. D. 485, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Preference to Maine Workmen and Contractors."

Amend said Bill in the first line of section 1 (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined punctuation and figure ",7" and in the 2nd line (first in L.D.) by striking out the punctuation and figure ", 7"

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 7.
