SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 385, L. D. 500, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Membership of the Advisory Committee for a Research and Advance Study Center at the University of Maine in Portland."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, a research and advance study center at the University of Maine in Portland is being constructed; and

Whereas, an advisory committee is authorized by chapter 183, section 9 of the private and special laws of 1967 to supervise all related activities in connection with the establishment of such center; and

Whereas, the present law authorizes the President of the University of Maine to appoint such an advisory committee and since the head of the university has been changed to Chancellor, the following legislation is vitally necessary to aid the duties and responsibilities of the committee as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the bill becomes effective as an emergency measure.
