Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 1960-A." of section 2 by inserting after the 11th underlined line "Mink" of subsection 2 (10th line in L.D.) a new underlined line to read as follows:

'Muskrats'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 1960-A." of section 2 by inserting at the end of subsection 2 the underlined line 'Other nongame wildlife'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add "muskrats" and "nongame wildlife" to the definition of "fur-bearing" animals.
