HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 391, L. D. 506, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Rendering of Treatment and Services to Minors for Drug Abuse Without Parental Consent."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 2606." of section 1 by adding before the period at the end the following:

'except that if such minor is under 17 years of age, the person licensed under this chapter shall inform such parent or guardian of such treatment within 48 hours'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 3154." of section 2 by adding before the period at the end the following:

'except that if such minor is under 17 years of age, the person licensed under this chapter shall inform such parent or guardian of such treatment within 48 hours'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 3817." of section 3 by adding before the period at the end the following:

'except that if such minor is under 17 years of age, the person

licensed under this chapter shall inform such parent or guardian of such service within 48 hours'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 4185-A." of section 3 by adding before the period at the end the following:

'except that if such minor is under 17 years of age, the person certified under this chapter shall inform such parent or guardian of such service within 48 hours'
