**AN ACT Relating to Fee for Certificate to Cremate Bodies
of Deceased Persons.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 1405, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 1405 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

For said certificate the medical examiner shall receive a fee of ~~\$5~~ \$10 payable by the person requesting same.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Medical examiners have found that the travel and time required to conform to the requirements of section 1405 of Title 32 are such that a fee of \$5 is no longer adequate compensation.
