COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 170, L. D. 522, Bill,  
"AN ACT Providing Funds for the Maine Police Academy."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General  
Fund to the Maine Police Academy, the sum of \$130,000 for the  
years 1971-72 and 1972-73 to provide for continuation of  
the functioning of the Maine Police Academy to provide police  
training for all criminal justice agencies in the State of Maine,  
except the State Police. The breakdown shall be as follows:
