**AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Chief Administrative Officer of County
Commissioners of Aroostook County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The next to the last paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The salaries mentioned in this section shall be in full compensation for the performance of all official duties by said officers and judges. County commissioners shall allow to said officers all office expense, clerk hire and travel which are necessary, just and proper to the performance of their official duties, except that the chief administrative officer of the board of county commissioners of Aroostook County shall receive all necessary expenses to the performance of his official duties, including his expenses of travel between the county seat and his home.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1971.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide payment of expenses for the chief administrative officer of the county commissioners of Aroostook County.
