COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 178, L. D. 530, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Board of Examiners for the Examination of
Applicants for Admission to the Bar and Applicants for Such
Examination."

Amend said Bill in the 5th and 6th lines after the amending
clause in section 3 (4th and 5th lines in L.D.) by striking out the
underlined words "proficiency he has attained in each branch or
subject upon which he has been examined" and inserting in place
thereof the underlined words 'results of the examinations'

Further amend said Bill in the 7th line after the amending
clause in section 3 (6th line in L.D.) by striking out the
underlined words "the first" and inserting in place thereof the
underlined word 'an'

Further amend said Bill in the 8th line after the amending
clause in section 3 (7th line in L.D.) by striking out the
underlined words "the next" and inserting in place thereof the
underlined word 'another'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the portion of the
bill relating to receiving results of bar exams by subject matter
and add that results only be provided and to delete the references
to "first" examination and "the first" and add "an" and "another".
