AN ACT Relating to Contracts of Teachers with Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2251, sub-§ 2, ¶ A, additional. Subsection 2 of section 2251 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 247 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding a new paragraph A to read as follows:

A. This subsection shall not apply to contracts of teachers, whether probationary or tenure, existing or prospective.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will permit teachers to serve municipalities as elected officials without penalty.
