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**RESOLVE, Providing Funds for Improvement of West Quoddy Head  
State Park Access Road.**

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**West Quoddy Head State Park; improvement of access road. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$7,000 to the Maine State Park and Recreation Commission to be expended toward the improvement of the access road to the state park at West Quoddy Head in Lubec, said access road being a town way in said Lubec and extending from State Aid Highway No. 3 easterly to the point of entrance to said park and being a distance of 1.24 miles, more or less.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this resolve is to provide funds to reconstruct and surface a dirt road running primarily on state-owned land to a state park which is presently being used to the detriment of private residences along such road and maintained within the limits of funds available by the Town of Lubec.
