STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Limit the Taking of Smelts in the Eastern River in the Town of Dresden to Hook and Line.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1959, c. 155, § 68-B, additional. Chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1959, as amended by chapter 35 of the private and special laws of 1965, is further amended by adding a new section 68-B to read as follows:

Sec. 68-B. Taking of smelts in Eastern River. The Eastern River in the Town of Dresden is closed to all smelt fishing, except by hook and line.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act would make it illegal to take smelts in the Eastern River in the Town of Dresden by any method but hook and line.
