RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing on Part of Moose River, Somerset County.

Resolves, 1963, c. 31, repealed and replaced. Resolved: That chapter 31 of the resolves of 1963, as repealed and replaced by chapter 40 of the resolves of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Fishing on part of Moose River, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue rules and regulations establishing on Moose River from Brassua Lake to Moosehead Lake in Rockwood Strip and Taunton, Raynham Grant, T1 R1, Somerset County, the opening for fishing under the general law from May 1st to September 15th of each year with a daily limit of 5 fish and the closing to all but fly fishing from September 16th to September 30th, with a daily limit of one fish.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow the use of live bait and to permit fishing under the general law on part of Moose River.
