HOUSE AMENDMENT "B " to H. P. 420, L. D. 547, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Municipal Public Employees Labor Relations Law."

Amend said Bill in the 7th line of section 9 (6th line in L. D.) by striking out the underlined figure "30%" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '10%'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 10 and by renumbering section 11 to be section 10.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow employees to prohibit union security by secret ballot if 10% express their desire to do so by petition and to retain existing law regarding grievance arbitration.
