SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 192, L. D. 553, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Suspension of Motor Vehicle Operator's  
License and Registration."


Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first paragraph  
of subsection 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'1. Suspension. The Secretary of State or any Deputy  
Secretary of State may suspend any certificate of registration  
or any license issued to any person to operate a motor vehicle  
or right to operate a motor vehicle or right to obtain an  
operator's license after hearing for any cause which he deems  
sufficient. He is also authorized to suspend any certificate  
of registration or any license issued to any person to operate  
a motor vehicle and privilege to operate a motor vehicle without  
preliminary hearing upon showing by his records or other  
sufficient evidence that the driver:'

Further amend said Bill in subsection 3 by inserting in  
the first line after the underlined word "person" the underlined  
words 'without preliminary hearing'
