COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 193, L. D. 554, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Examinations for Certain Occupations by  
Graduates of Maine Vocational Technical Institutes."

Amend said Bill in the 7th line (5th and 6th in L. D.)  
by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "barbering,  
hairdressing and beauty culture,"

Further amend said Bill in the 10th line (8th in L. D.)  
by inserting after the underlined word "boards" the following:  
'and upon satisfactory completion of a series of teaching units  
in the electrical or plumbing program, as approved by the respective  
licensing board, followed by 2,000 hours of on-the-job experience,  
one year credit may be given for hours worked by students during the  
summer. Such person shall be eligible to write the exam'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to provide for a  
series of teaching units in the electrical, oil burner, or  
plumbing programs as approved by the licensing board, after which  
upon satisfactory completion a person would be eligible to write  
an exam.
