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## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 424, L. D. 558, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Tenants Serving on Local Housing Authorities."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 30, § 4602, sub-§1, ¶ A, amended. The first sentence of paragraph A of subsection 1 of section 4602 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 8 of chapter 470 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Each authority shall have 5 commissioners appointed, at least one of whom shall be a resident of an existing public housing project or a person who would otherwise qualify for public housing under applicable standards, including standards of the United States

Department of Housing and Urban Development.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to leave the membership of housing authorities at 5 with at least one member a person who would qualify for public housing under applicable standards.
