STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Retailer under Liquor Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 28, § 2, sub-§ 19-A, additional. Section 2 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 19-A, to read as follows:
- 19-A. Retailer. "Retailer" shall mean and include persons licensed by the commission to engage in the purchase and resale of malt or brewed beverages or wines, or both, in the original containers as purchased from a duly licensed wholesaler to be resold for consumption off the premises only.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to define "retailer" under the liquor law.
