AN ACT Relating to Issuance of Malt Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 701, amended. The 4th paragraph from the end of section 701 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

All full-year licenses shall be issued for ~~the license one year and on a calendar year basis~~ **from date of issuance** and the prescribed fee shall accompany the application for license.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would eliminate the jam of renewals of malt liquor licenses at the end of December.
