COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 433, L.D. 568, Bill, "AN ACT Permitting the Establishment of a Pleasant Point Passamaquoddy School Committee."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>§4840.</u>" by striking out all of the second underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence: '<u>Residents of the Passamaquoddy Indian reservation at Pleasant</u> <u>Point shall by popular election elect persons to the school</u> <u>committee in the same manner and subject to the terms of office</u> <u>provided in Title 20, section 472.</u>'

It is the intent of this amendment to make the provisions of the bill conform with the general law.
