COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 433, L.D. 568, Bill, "AN ACT Permitting the Establishment of a Pleasant Point Passamaquoddy School Committee."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§4840." by striking out all of the second underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:
'Residents of the Passamaquoddy Indian reservation at Pleasant Point shall by popular election elect persons to the school committee in the same manner and subject to the terms of office provided in Title 20, section 472.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to make the provisions of the bill conform with the general law.
