COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 442, L. D. 577, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Elderly Persons' Examinations for Motor Vehicle  
Operators' Licenses."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the beginning of the first  
line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure  
"Sec. 1."

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 5th line (4th line  
of L. D.) the underlined figure "50th" and inserting in place thereof  
the underlined figure '60th'; and by striking out in the 10th line  
(8th line of L. D.) the underlined figure "49th" and inserting in  
place thereof the underlined figure '59th'; and by striking out in  
the 12th line (10th line of L. D.) the underlined figure "51st"  
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '61st'; and  
by striking out in the 14th line (12th line of L. D.) the underlined  
figures and word "50 or 51" and inserting in place thereof the  
underlined figures and word '60 or 61'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is in raising the age from 50 to 60  
for vision exams adds approximately 35,000 applicants who will have to  
have vision examinations upon renewal. Recently passed legislation  
makes the appropriation on the original bill unnecessary.
