AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Littering.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 2251, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 2251 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 83 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

Any person who violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not ~~more~~ less than \$100 nor more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 10 days, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the penalty for littering.
