HOUSE AMENDMENT " C " to H. P. 471, L. D. 599, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Riding in Trailers."

Amend said Bill by striking out the period at the end of
that part designated "§958." and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'at a speed in excess of 15 miles per hour. This section shall
not apply to an employee in the necessary discharge of his duties
to his employer nor to any trailer being utilized for farming or
agricultural purposes.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to:

1. Set a speed limit in excess of 15 miles per hour;
2. Exempt employees in the discharge of their duties; and
3. Exempt farming or agricultural purposes.
