AN ACT Relating to Riding in Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 958, repealed and replaced. Section 958 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 16 of chapter 245 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 958. Riding in trailers

No person or persons shall occupy any camp trailer, house trailer, semi-trailer or trailer while it is being moved upon a public highway.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prevent people from occupying any type of trailer while it is being moved on a highway.
